Local artist showcases 'Avian Odes' at Viewpoints

Viewpoints Gallery has scheduled "Avian Odes," an exhibition of visual poems built around studies of Bay Area birds by watercolor artist Floy Zittin, Feb. 1-29. An artist's reception is scheduled 2-5 p.m. Feb. 3 at the gallery, 315 State St., Los Altos.

Zittin combines a background in scientific illustration with a talent for Asian brushwork. She has experimented with splash-painting techniques and watercolor on canvas. These paintings can be framed like oil paintings, without glass, bringing the viewer closer to the image.

Zittin began her art career as a scientific illustrator in British Columbia. She teaches classes in watercolor technique as part of the adult education program in the Mountain View-Los Altos and Sequoia school districts.
